Chris Reilly reports we have \$10,913.42 as of close of business February 28, 2018. We received a \$6,000 grant from the Town for 2018. We will set up a committee meeting to propose how to spend this money. Suffolk Co. reimburses our expenditures. Maryanne asked members to think of items we need to purchase for the Davis House and our society.

Historian's Report

Mildred Zimmermann brought in a horseshoe from the property and noted that the Davis family raced horses when there was a track in Riverhead, NY.

Old Business

- 1. Bob Kessler reported on progress on Davis House.
 - a. No work could be done because grounds were too muddy from storm. Friday, March 9th is next projected day for work on house. Trim and spackling work will be done. The new beams have been ordered. The old ones will be removed by town and then the new beams will be installed.
 - b. It is projected the upstairs plastering will be done this summer for a cost of \$30,000.
 - c. The Town submitted a \$3,000 deposit for the Town to purchase the staircase. The back staircase will be refurbished and reused.
- 2. The Victorian Tea committee had its first meeting jobs were assigned. Margaret will give a short seminar on Lewis Carroll.
 - a. Lisa and Ellen will set up tables.
 - b. Ellen requested male members help with clean up as the work of the tea is physically taxing.
 - c. Chris will try to get school students to help with the serving.
 - d. Barbara posted to Facebook information about the tea.
- 3. We discussed more possible speakers for our 2018 meetings.

- 4. Members agreed to accept furniture that Whitney Davis is willing to bring up for the April 7th Davis Family Memorial at the Davis House.
 - a. Assembl. Englebright, TOB Sup. Romaine and SC Leg. Anker will speak. Family only will go on to Union Cemetery. Board members will attend a catered dinner at the Swezey-Avey House given by the Davis family.

New Business

- 2. We discussed the Old School House as a storage area. Van Johnson noted it is getting crowded. Empty boxes will be removed.
- 3. Davis furniture will be stored in attic of Davis House.

Open Discussion

Members discussed feasibility of our society taking on the "saving" of the Captain Norton House. Maryanne noted Emma Norton was once Postmistress. Chris advised Maryanne to contact Ed Romaine as he may have answers to member questions about possible purchase of land. Brush debris and house debris will need to be cleaned up.
