Membership Report

Chris reported that there are 73 due paying members as of May 2, 2016 which is up from 64.

Historian's Report

Mildred presented a 1953 newsletter about Davis House. Steve presented a Coram Community Club booklet from July 4, 1959.

New Business

Bob Kessler and the workers from the county jail trimmed 3 windows, redid the chimney, repaired and rebuilt all chimneys and cleaned out the house. Bob Kessler handed in receipts to Chris for work and supplies on house construction. We have \$175,000 from town. Heat needs to be put in the upstairs of house and National Grid can take as long as 8 months to put house online.

Open Discussion

We discussed furnishings we have for house. We have some antique beds. We discussed how rooms may be set up. The Coram Civic Association will need a room. Upstairs re-plastering needs to be done and sheetrock installed downstairs. The Gardiner Foundation is going to help with grant money. We will have a yard sale at the Davis House September 10th.
